Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ for the faith of God's elect and the knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness—faith and knowledge resting on the hope of eternal life, which God, who does not lie, promised before the beginning of time, and at his appointed season he brought his word to light through the preaching entrusted to me by the command of God our Savior, To Titus, my true son in our common faith:

Titus

- Gentile
- · Conversion caused a stir in Jerusalem
- · Paul was his spiritual father or mentor
- Traveled with Paul on several missionary journeys
- Worked with the church at Corinth

Crete

- Sleazy seaport
- · Socially backward, destroyed by an earthquake
- Character traits: "The people of Crete are all liars, cruel animals, and lazy gluttons."
- Paul planted the church in Crete

Who we are

- Servants v.1
- Sent ones v.1

What we are sent to do

- Help people to faith in Jesus v.1
- Help people learn knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness v.1

Context of our work: Our certainty of Eternity
